- pozna vpliv uvajanja informacijsko-komunikacijskih tehnologij na naravo političnih procesov;
- se zaveda izzivov e-participacije in e-demokracije.

- knows the impact of information-communication technologies (ICT) on political dynamics;
- is aware of challenges of e-participation and e-democracy.

### **Metode poučevanja in učenja:**
